Check list of Important Items for Exhibitors

- Call ahead if you have special needs
- Enter through the main gate
- After you have unloaded please Park your pickup/trailer in designated areas south of the Church and the north end of the main parking area. Please do not park in front of the loading dock.
- Please DO NOT Leave vehicles and equipment in the fire or driving lanes. It is important to keep these open for emergency vehicles.
- Think when parking to avoid boxing anyone in.
- DO NOT PARK ON THE GROUNDS-USE THE PARKING LOTS KEEP THE GROUNDS LOOKING HISTORIC
- All operators need a valid driver's license.
